



The International Naval Contest (INC) takes place every year on the second weekend of December. This year, **FNARS**, the "Finnish Naval Amateur Radio Society", will be sponsor of the International Naval Contest.

When: 13th December 2014 16:00 UTC to 14th December 2014 15:59 UTC

Bands: 3.5 - 7 - 14 - 21 - 28 MHz

Preferred frequencies: CW: 3,565 - 7,020 - 14,055 - 21,160 - 28,350 MHz
SSB: 3,625 - 7,060 - 14,303 - 21,175 - 28,993 MHz

Mode: CW - SSB - Mixed

Information's to be given on contact:

1. Naval Club Member: RST+CLUB+MEMBERSHIP NUMBER (eg. "599 FN150")
2. Non Naval Member: RST+NUMBER (eg. "599 001")

Points:

1. Naval club members: 10 points
2. Non-Naval members: 1 point

Rules:

1. Every contacted and logged member of a participating Naval Club.
2. Every station only counted once as a multiplier during the contest regardless of the number of bands you work them on.
3. Participation in the contest is allowed only under **one** membership number.

Score: Total QSO points * Multipliers = total score
